

# Additional Information for the ASTI Meter Relays

The relays on the 4TX meters have only NO & COM terminals available unlike some older meter that have NO, NC & COM terminals on their rear panels.

#### Procedure for resetting the relays without having to recalibrate.

For model 4TX follow this procedure to directly reach the Relay setting without having to recalibrate.

- 1. Press "MODE" key and select "CAL" then press "OK" key to enter calibration mode.
- 2. Select 'PH", if in pH mode, then press "OK" key to enter ATC select mode.
- 3. Select correct ATC type then press "OK" key to enter 1<sup>st</sup> BUFFER select mode.
- 4. Select first buffer then press "OK" key to enter 2<sup>nd</sup> BUFFER select mode
- 5. Select second buffer then press "OK" key to enter 1<sup>st</sup> buffer calibration mode
- 6. Press "RIGHT ARROW" key and you can skip the buffer calibration
- 7. Press the "OK " key till the parameter you want is re-set.

In the model 4TX series you can press CAL/VIEW key to skip to next page.

## This is what you is required to access directly the relay settings.

Pressing the [CAL/VIEW] key for about two seconds during the main display mode will bring up the first page, (PASSWORD) of the six pages of the Calibration/Setting mode in the menu. Pressing the [CAL/VIEW] key again will enter the view change page, VIE/CHANG, pressing the [CAL/VIEW] key again will enter the pH calibration page, pressing the [CAL/VIEW] key again will enter pH control setting page. This is what you need to access directly the relay settings.


## See Page two for the typical 4TX Menu Flow Chart



#### B. CALIBRATION/SETTING MODE

Pressing the [CAL/VIEW] key for about 2 seconds during main display mode will bring-up the first page of 6 pages of the Calibration/Setting mode. Pressing [CAL/VIEW] key will switch to the next page until the last page, where pressing [CAL/VIEW] again will return the user to main display mode.

Below is a simple flowchart showing the path of the [CAL/VIEW] key:



You can change any blinking options or digit by pressing the  $[\land]$  or  $[\lor]$  keys. For options in digit format you need to press the [**MODE/--**] key to move to the next digit. If you are satisfied with the selection you made you need to press the  $[ \downarrow ]$  **ENTER** key to save the changes and move to the next option. If you don't need to change the current blinking option just press the  $[ \downarrow ]$  **ENTER** key to move to the next selection. You also can press and hold this key for 2 seconds will move you back to the previous parameter.
